Part A: Definitions of Terms Used on Stock Tables

TERMS	DEFINITIONS
52 Week High	<i>The highest price that a stock has traded at during the previous year</i>
52 Week Low	<i>The lowest price that a stock has traded at during the previous year</i>
Stock Symbols	<i>A unique series of letters assigned to a security for trading purposes</i>
Dividends/Share	<i>A share of a company's profits passed on to the shareholders on a periodic basis</i>
Volume	<i>The number of stock shares traded during a given period of time</i>
Yield	<i>The return or earnings for investing in a stock</i>
Price	<i>The amount paid to purchase a stock</i>
Earnings/Share	<i>A company's profit per share of stock</i>
P/E	<i>A number calculated from the price per share of the stock divided by the earnings per share of that stock for the past 12 months; indicates the value of a stock</i>
Day Last	<i>The price of a stock at the last trade of the day</i>
Net Change	<i>The difference between the closing price of a stock on the current trading day and the previous day's closing price</i>

The following terms provide additional information included on these web sites about the value of stocks for potential buyers and sellers. TERMS	DEFINITIONS
Previous Close	<i>The closing price of a stock on the prior day of trading</i>
Open	<i>The price of a stock's first transaction on a day of trading</i>
Bid	<i>The price a potential buyer is willing to pay for a share of stock</i>
Ask	<i>The price at which a stockholder is willing to sell shares of stock</i>
% Change	<i>The difference between the current price and the previous day's price of a stock</i>
Day's High	<i>The highest price that a stock has traded that day</i>
Day's Low	<i>The lowest price that a stock has traded that day</i>
52 Week Average	<i>The average stock price for the past year</i>
Average Volume	<i>The average number of stock transactions, generally for the past year</i>
Market Cap	<i>The value of a company based on its number of outstanding shares times the current price of a single share</i>
Exchange	<i>The market where the stock is listed for trading</i>
